2025 Official Tennessee Road map scavenger hunt

Use the official highway map of Tennessee to answer these questions. Use the map itself, its legend, the Index of Tennessee Counties, the Index of Tennessee Cities, and the mileage chart to the right of the East Tennessee side of the map. (Questions 11, 12 and 15 cannot be answered using the online version of this map.)

- 1) What interstate goes from Memphis to Nashville to Knoxville?
- 2) Besides Shelby County, what is the only other West Tennessee county that has a bridge across the Mississippi River?
- 3) In what time zone is Cumberland County (Central Standard Time or Eastern Standard Time)?
- 4) What are the numbers of the three interstate exits that people use from Interstate 40 to get to Brownsville?
- 5) What highway takes you directly from Huntington (Carroll County) to Dresden (Weakley County)?
- 6) What is the name of the man-made lake in the southeastern part of Nashville?
- 7) Using the city maps, what two rivers merge to form the Tennessee River just upstream from Knoxville?
- 8) What is the national scenic highway called in the eastern part of Monroe County?
- 9) What is it that makes the Tipton County community of Reverie an unusual place?
- 10) What is the name of the large state park between Spencer and Pikeville?
- 11) (Using the mileage chart on the east side of the map), how far is it from Nashville to Knoxville?
- 12) How far is it from Memphis to Bristol?
- 13) What is the elevation of Clingman's Dome (in the Great Smoky Mountains)?
- 14) What is the county seat of Hancock County? (County seats are in yellow.)
- 15) If you leave Memphis heading east on U.S. Highway 64, you will pass through 9 counties on your way to Fayetteville. List those 9 counties.
