Acre—a piece of land about the size of three-fourths of a football field

Ambush—an unexpected attack from a hidden position

Atrocity—a horrible deed

Blockade—sealing off a place to prevent people or goods from passing through

Census—an official count of the population

Delineation—description or outline

Deserter—a person who used to be a soldier but who ran away from service with no intention of returning

Inevitable—certain to happen, unavoidable

Migration—movement of a people from one place to another

Militia—a body of citizen soldiers (people who aren't full-time soldiers)

Mortal—Deadly

Muscogee (also spelled Muskogee)— Creek Indians

Revenge—to get back at someone for doing something mean to you

Station—a fort

Treaty—a written agreement between two nations, often after war

Truce—a temporary stoppage of fighting

Tsalagi—Cherokee Indians

Yuchi—a Native American tribe that (in Tennessee) was partly taken over by the Cherokee tribe in the early 1700s
